Pair competition: 2 athletes (m+f) **Team competition:** 3 athletes (m+m+m / f+f+f) On principle all members of a pair / team must be of the appropriate age. Age categories are based on the year of birth.





Method of Competition – Recognized Poomsae

Recognized Poomsae: Single Elimination Tournament System

Competition shall be conducted in a single elimination tournament. **Designated Poomsae shall** be randomly selected and shown through monitor on Field of Play before the match begins.

Individual Categories: Contestants shall perform two (2) randomly selected Poomsae. Both Chung and Hong player perform designated Poomsae at the same time (side by side).

Pair and Team Categories: Contestants shall perform two (2) randomly selected Poomsae. Chung and Hong player perform designated Poomsae one by one (not side by side).

<u>Note:</u> The organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Poomsae to be performed in the preliminary rounds to one (1) Poomsae.

A certain number of athletes may be seeded based on their ranks in the WT world ranking, according to the guidelines stipulated in the WT World Poomsae Ranking. If an athlete has no ranking points, he or she will not be seeded and will be placed in a random draw. Medals shall be awarded to the top four (4) contestants.

Ending Position: According to the new WT Rules and regulation there is no deductions in Poomsae Performance for ending positions that differ from the starting position.

Age categories are based on the year of birth.

^{*} Note: Only for Free Style Poomsae Mixed Team of Over 17, if the age of a team's each member does not consist of 18 years old or older, the Mixed Team can be formed with up to maximum two of members under the age of 18 (12-17).





Method of Competition - Free Style Poomsae

Free Style Poomsae: Cut-off System

Cut-off system for all Freestyle categories: Single Final Round (only 1 round), independent of number of athletes

- Each performance shall have a duration from 90 seconds to 100 seconds.
- Performed techniques must be within the boundaries of taekwondo.
- Scoring shall be made in accordance with the rules of the WT.
- Music & choreography shall be the choice of the contestant.
- Freestyle athletes will also be required to submit their music in a USB-Stick to OC on the day of registration

Mixed Team Divisions - Board Breaking

Board breakings in the following three technical skills are required:

Gradients of spins in a spin kick
 Kyorugi style consecutive kicks
 Acrobatic kicking technique
 (1 to 3 boards) minimum 1 boards
 (3 to 5 boards) minimum 1 board
 (1 to 3 boards) minimum 1 board

- Minimum number of breaking during a Performance: 5 (1+3+1) boards.
- Board Breaking: The pine board has the following measurements:

Length 300 mm Width 220 mm

Thickness 9 mm (ca. 1/4 inch)

- 9 boards (max. number of Board) per team will be provided by OC.
- All boards must remain within the boundary line; otherwise, deductions will be applied.
- Board holding sticks prepared by teams are allowed for only the acrobatic board breaking technique.
- Holder of the board breaking can only be within the 5 members of the mixed team. Any of the five performing members (not substitute) can execute board breakings.





The Followings are allowed during the Board Breaking:

- **Gradients of spins in a spin kick (**Jump Turn Kick): Piggyback allowed only. Piggyback means sitting (not standing) on a teammate's shoulders to hold a board.
- Acrobatic kicking technique (Acrobatic Kick): support/boosting and piggyback. Support/Boosting means assisting a teammate's jump.

Free Style Poomsae - General Information for all categories

- All Acrobatic techniques must incorporate **Taekwondo kicks**.
- Consecutive sparring kicks (7 10 kicks) Minimum 7 consecutive kicks
- Punches are not counted for "minimum 7 consecutive sparing kicks"
- Mandatory Stances: Hakdari Seogi, Beomseogi, and Dwigubi All stances must be performed clearly and accurately. For pair and mixed team, athletes must perform the stances at the same time.





Rules

Competition Rules

WT Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation in force as of June 14, 2024 shall apply.

Condition for Participation

WT Global Athlete License (GAL) is mandatory for all competitors in WT categories. All participants must have a valid 2025 GAL License to participate at this event. Please contact your MNA or club admin to apply for the WT Global License. All participants must be prepared to proof their age by presenting their valid passport or ID-card at registration. Starting permission for children and minors lies within the clubs' responsibility (mind the liability exclusion!). By filing the application, the contestants agree that their names will be published on the list of participants and result lists in the internet.

Qualification Requirements (Belt Requirements)

Kids / Children 2nd Geup and higher

Cadet, Junior and Senior Athletes Holder of 1st Dan/Poom and above (WT regulations)

Note: According to WT Poomsae Competition Rules, Contestants may compete in maximum two (2) categories (Recognized Poomsae & Freestyle Poomsae combined) of competition unless he or she is limited by gender or age. For example: Recognized Poomsae max 2, or Freestyle Poomsae max 2, or 1 each of categories

Coach Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years
- 2. Holder of the WT Coach License Poomsae Level 1 Coach Certification
- 3. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License
- 4. Coaches are not allowed to wear Dobok.

Protective Equipment & Uniform

The participants shall wear the WT recognized Taekwondo Uniform.

New Partner Invitation Function for Poomsae Event: WT GMS has implemented a new function for an individual member to invite partner (s) for Pairs and Teams Poomsae. During the registration for a Poomsae event, there is a new button called "**Invite/Add**". Your partner will receive an email about the invitation, then he/she needs to accept the invitation by registering through GMS to the 2025 Turkish Open (Poomsae). DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS & PAYMENTS (regular registration):

January 24, 2025, 23:59 Istanbul time

Late registration period will be between <u>January 25 - 31, 2025</u>. Registration fee for late registration will be €180 after January 24, 2025.

There will be **NO** Onsite Registration.

IMPORTANT: If the athlete registered online does not take part in the competition for some reason, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants/team before **deadline** (**January 24, 2025**) his/her team officially must fully (%100) pay his/her entry fee for the participation or else athlete/athletes from their team cannot participate in the tournament. Registration fee payments should be **completed** on January 24, 2025; Please consider the SWIFT durations.

Entry fees: The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an **entry fee via bank transfer** and the Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

Note: Consider the Corresponding Bank Fee, be aware that they can deduct a service fee.

Team awards

The Team Standings is determined by the sum of the results of the individuals in a team. **Team awards will be given out to the top five (5) teams.**

ACCOMMODATION

Anti-doping

The competitor accepts the Anti-Doping rules of the World Taekwondo Federation and the National Anti-Doping Agency (Turkish Anti-Doping Commission).

With the application all athletes commit themselves to refraining from all actions which are incompatible with the principles of fairness in sport and ensuring by all means at their disposal that no prohibited substances enter their body tissue or body fluids and no prohibited methods are used on them.





INSURANCE

Insurance

The organization and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, losses and injuries during the stay in Turkiye.

All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Turkiye. If not, this will have to be paid in cash.

First Aid will be provided by the organization and is only to be used in case of an emergency.

Indemnities

The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships. The Organizing Committee will acquire general insurance, at its own expenses, for all participants of the tournament, including but not limited to contestants and staff, in the event of any injury and/or damages that may arise during the championships.

Roles and Rules

The organizer will keep a register that includes contacts of competitors and members of their entourage, officials and professionals, which will facilitate the identification and monitoring of further contacts of potentially infected persons. The keeping of the register will be in accordance with local legislation and regulations, and in accordance with the protection of personal data. By accepting the work, volunteering or registering, all participants undertake to give a statement and accept the conditions prescribed by the organizer.

This rulebook is designed for and binds all participants in the organization who accept the stated instructions by taking over the official accreditation.
