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#### **Rules**

#### **Competition Rules**

WT Para Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation in force as of September 30, 2024.

#### **Conditions for Participation (Qualification)**

- WT Global Athlete License (GAL) is mandatory for all competitors. All participants must have a valid 2025-GAL License to participate at this event. Please contact your MNA or club admin to apply for the WT Global License.
- A Para Taekwondo Poomsae Athlete shall be **at least 16 years old** in the year of 2025 (born no later than December 31, 2009)
- All participants must be prepared to proof their age by presenting their valid passport or ID-card at registration.
- Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued or recognized by WT or an 8-1 Geup certificate issued or recognized by WT.
- Athlete must go through International Classification in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament. Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) or with a Classification Not Complete (CNC) will not be able to compete.

By filing the application, the contestants agree that their names will be published on the list of participants and result lists on the internet.

#### **Qualification Requirements (Belt Requirements)**

Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued or recognized by WT or an 8th-1st Geup certificate issued or recognized by WT.

#### **Coach Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years
- 2. Holder of the World Para Taekwondo International Coach Certificate Level I
- 3. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License
- 4. Coaches are not allowed to wear Dobok.

#### **Athlete Uniforms**

Contestants shall wear WT-approved Poomsae competition uniform or the standard white taekwondo uniform at WT-recognized Para Poomsae Championships. #### **Method of Competition**

#### Single Elimination Tournament System (Altering athletes).

Competition shall be conducted in a single elimination tournament. Chong first and then Hong (depending on number of participants, tournament can start from R64, R32, R16, R8, R4 or R2)

#### Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) for P20, P30, P50 & P70

The Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) is to be completed in English by the athlete's individual physician or physic therapist.

The completed form must be submitted **no later than January 26, 2025**, before the athlete undergoes athlete evaluation. This applies to all athletes with an intellectual or physical impairment competing in Para Taekwondo Poomsae.

Depending on the athlete's health condition and impairment, additional medical information is to be attached to this form (see page 2). Please consult the WT Classification rules for a list of eligible impairments and underlying health conditions for Poomsae.

There will be separate MDFs for P20, P30, P50, P70.

For the P20 Sport there will be an "MDF" for P20. **IQ test** from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If AAI is present with downs syndrome this needs to be noted too.

<u>Link to download MDF</u> - Teams should have with them a translator who has good understanding of English.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a "Classification Not Complete", "CNC". The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT Classification Evaluation Group to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All the athlete in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).









Medical Diagnostics Form through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) Medical Diagnostic Form must be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athlete registered for the tournament. The deadline for uploading MDFs to the WTCS is on the registration deadline (Jan 26).

\*WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

**Virtus Classification System P20 Sport Class** - For the P20 Sport Class, Virtus International Eligibility is recognized. However, Sport Specific classification is required. New P20 athletes needs to fill out the "MDF" for P20 and upload to WTCS with a photo. IQ test (full) and Adaptive Behaviour Test from verified psychologist will be required as well as medical report. If the athlete has downs syndrome, neck x-ray and a medical report to rule out AAI needs to be provided. All documents shall be uploaded to WTCS.

#### Classification schedule and Location

Classification schedule will be sent out following close of registration. Classification will take place on **February 06-07**, **2025**. Please ensure to book your tickets so that Athlete will be in Antalya on February 06-07, 2025. Changes to classification schedule will not be made once announced. Athlete classification will be held in the **Venue**.

**Guidelines for international athlete classification** - The athlete should be wearing sport clothes (track suit). The athlete also needs to bring their uniform (Dobok) and all personal protective equipment or assistive devices. The athlete should also bring any relevant medical information to classification.

The athlete should always do their best on the tests and exercises requested by the International Classifiers.

#### **Compulsory Poomsae**

For all Sport Classes there is a free choice to athletes to choose one (1) Poomsae from Group 1 and one (1) Poomsae from Group 2 for each round.

<sup>\*</sup>Poomsae Keumgang shall be excluded from P30 sport classes

Athletes in the P20 Sport Classes will be free to choose their Poomsae for each stage of competition.

#### **Duration of Contest**

Duration of competitions between 20 to 120 seconds for each Poomsae. Break (resting period) is at least a one (1) minute between each Poomsae. If the opponent completes their Poomsae early or decides not to perform their Poomsae, the competitor will be given a minimum of one (1) minute of break in between each Poomsae.

Late registration period will be between <u>January 21 - 31, 2025</u>.

Registration fee for late registration will be €180 after January 24, 2025.

There will be NO Onsite Registration.

**IMPORTANT:** If the athlete registered online does not take part in the competition for some reason, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants/team before **deadline** (**January 20, 2025**) his/her team officially must fully (%100) pay his/her entry fee for the participation or else athlete/athletes from their team cannot participate in the tournament. Registration fee payments should be **completed** on January 20, 2025; **Please consider the SWIFT durations.** 

Entry fees: The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an **entry fee via bank transfer** and the Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

After you send the SWIFT MT103 Document, your payment can be recognized/found easily and you can be informed if the amount you have to pay completely reached to us, and if the amount is not reached to us completely, we will inform you based on our records and you can send the rest of the amount.

Note: Consider the Corresponding Bank Fee, be aware that they can deduct a service fee.





NOTE: Bank transaction expenses should be set to "OUR". If set to "SHA" then the team may be asked to pay at the Registration & Accreditation Centre, any differences that may occur at the final amount remitted. Türkiye Taekwondo Federasyonu has a NO REFUND policy.

Each Team is responsible for submitting the Protest in the proper manner and according to the rules and regulations.

Referees	

Only International Referees will be accepted. An official invitation for the referees will be sent to all Federations.





#### **Awards**

The medal ceremony will take place IMMEDIATELY after the end of the final fights of certain categories. All fights will take place according to a predetermined schedule.

#### **Team awards**

The Team Standings is determined by the sum of the results of the individuals in a team.

Team awards will be given out to the top Three (3) teams.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

All teams participating in 12th Turkish Open can book their hotel rooms via the Organizing Committee or at their own will.

#### **Anti-doping**

The competitor accepts the Anti-Doping rules of the World Taekwondo Federation and the National Anti-Doping Agency (Turkish Anti-Doping Commission).

With the application all athletes commit themselves to refraining from all actions which are incompatible with the principles of fairness in sport and ensuring at their disposal that no prohibited substances enter their body tissue or body fluids, and no prohibited methods are used on them.





#### **INSURANCE**

#### Insurance

The organization and supervisor assume no responsibility for teams, any damages, violence, losses and injuries during the stay in Türkiye.

All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Türkiye. If not, this will have to be paid in cash.

First Aid will be provided by the organization and is only to be used in case of an emergency.

#### **Indemnities**

The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships. The Organizing Committee will acquire general insurance, at its own expenses, for all participants of the tournament, including but not limited to contestants and staff, in the event of any injury and/or damages that may arise during the championships.

#### **Roles and Rules**

The organizer will keep a register that includes contacts of competitors and members of their entourage, officials and professionals, which will facilitate the identification and monitoring of further contacts of potentially infected persons. The keeping of the register will be in accordance with local legislation and regulations, and in accordance with the protection of personal data. By accepting the work, volunteering or registering, all participants undertake to give a statement and accept the conditions prescribed by the organizer.

This rulebook is designed for and binds all participants in the organization who accept the stated instructions by taking over the official accreditation.
